Project Description	<p>Continue Linear Reserves partnership project to protect critically endangered GEW and NTG of the Victorian Volcanic Plains on roadsides, rail reserves and cemeteries.</p> <p>Extend the current program to establish native seeds in small patches of bare ground post planned burns and targeted weed control. Seed addition is required to reduce weeds from re-established and promote more coverage and diversity of native species</p> <p>Small scale (low cost) restoration will occur via hand direct seeding disturbed areas within high quality grasslands. Seed can be collected from other linear reserves or purchase as needed.</p>
